Eph. 3: “¹⁴For this cause I _____ bow my _____ knees unto the Father of our _____ Lord Jesus Christ, ¹⁵Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, ¹⁶That he would grant you _____, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the _____ inner man; ¹⁷That Christ may dwell in your _____ heart by faith; that ye _____, being rooted and grounded in love, ¹⁸May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; ¹⁹And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, and ye _____ might be filled with all the fullness of God. ²⁰Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us _____. ²¹Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end.”
