

How to Walk in the God-Kind of Love

1 Cor. 13:4-8; Matt. 22:37-40; Mark 12:29-31; Luke 10:27; Mark 11:22-26; Rom. 5:5-8; 1 John 3:4; Gal. 5:6; Gal. 5:22; Ps. 91:14-16

1 Cor. 13:4-8 (AMP) tells us, “⁴Love endures long and is patient and kind; love never is envious nor boils over with jealousy, is not boastful or vainglorious, does not display itself haughtily. ⁵It is not conceited—arrogant and inflated with pride; it is not rude (unmannerly) and does not act unbecomingly. Love (God’s love in us) does not insist on its own rights or its own way, for it is not self-seeking; it is not touchy or fretful or resentful; it takes no account of the evil done to it (it pays no attention to a suffered wrong). ⁶It does not rejoice at injustice and unrighteousness, but rejoices when right and truth prevail. ⁷Love bears up under anything and everything that comes, is ever ready to believe the best of every person, its hopes are fadeless under all circumstances, and it endures everything (without weakening). ⁸Love never fails (never fades out or becomes obsolete or comes to an end).”

Mark 12:30-31 says, “³⁰And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength [ability]: this is the first commandment. ³¹And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.”
